Contents: The altar of incense and the brazen laver.

Characters: God, Moses, Aaron.

Conclusion: (See Psalms 141:2). The prayer of a contrite believer ascends

as a fragrant cloud to God. (Proverbs 15:8).

Key Word: Incense (worship), 7.

Strong Verses: 30.

Striking Facts: Fire under the incense altar brought out the fragrance (Romans 8:26-27). The fire was from the blood-sprinkled altar (Hebrews 10:19-20). Their prayers were based on the intercession of a priest (Romans 8:34).
