Contents: The burnt offering laws.

Characters: GOD, Moses, Aaron's sons.

Conclusion: We depend on the sacrifices, because they represent the great sacrifice of *CHRIST* on which all of our iniquity was laid which is *GOD*'s requirement. (The laying on of the offerer's hands signified identification of the believer with his offering).

Key Word: Burnt sacrifice, 3.

Strong Verses: 4.

Striking Facts: The burnt offering stands for **CHRIST** who offered **HIMSELF** without spot or blemish to **GOD** in delight to do the Father's will even if death was required. Fire, the symbol of **GOD**'s holiness, consumes the offering.
