**Contents:** Separation of the priests; perfection of the sacrifices.

**Characters:** **GOD**, Moses, Aaron and sons.

**Conclusion:** Guilt is contracted by those who profane sacred things, doing them in their own uncleanness. All service are to be directed only to **GOD**.

**Key Word:** Separate, 2.

**Strong Verses:** 3, 31, 32.

**Striking Facts:** Verse 19... a law to make sacrifices as a foreshadowing **CHRIST**, who is the great Sacrifice from which give all sacrifices derive their virtue.

**CHRIST** is called a “***lamb without spot and without blemish***” (1 Peter 1:19)
