**Striking Facts:** 28. This is a pivotal point in the ministry of **JESUS**. The **SAVIOR-KING** is rejected by the Jews, now offers rest and service to non-Jews who are conscious of their need. To these **He** will give rest (peace with God and the rest of salvation See Romans 5:1), and in **HIS** service they shall **continually** FIND rest (the peace of God. See Philippians 4:7).
