Defeating the enemy 101

Contents: The temptation of **JESUS**, and **JESUS**'s response. **JESUS**' public ministry begans. The Call of first disciples.

Characters: *JESUS*, satan, John the Baptist, Peter, Andrew, James, John, Isaiah.

Conclusion: The **WORD OF GOD** is the **Sword of the Spirit**, which if rightly handled, will deal defeat to satan in his attempts to snare the believer by <u>tempting suggestions</u>. [See James 1:14] Beware of satanic twisting of Scripture—"rightly divide the Word of Truth." [2 Timothy 2:15]

Key Word: Temptation.

Strong Verses: 4, 6,10.

Striking Facts: "If **JESUS** was without a sinful nature, why would/could **HE** be tempted?" Consider this: A city can be attacked even though the chances of success were so small as to be impossible. Additionally, acid can not corrode all. satan applied his test to **CHRIST**, and.... did not succeed. Note comparison of **JESUS**" temptations with those of the first Adam.

- (1). **Lust of the flesh** using **JESUS'** physical hunger
- (2). **Material things** offering the glory of kingdoms of the earth, contrary to **GOD**'s will and way, and,
- (3). **Pride of the life** tempting **JESUS** to throw Himself from pinnacle of the temple.
