Contents: *JESUS* heals 1.) A leper, 2.) The centurion's servant, and 3.) Peter's mother-in-law. Some disciples were tested. Calming the stormy seas. The ungrateful people of Gadara.

Characters: *JESUS*, leper, The centurion's servant, Peter's mother-in-law, two men of Gergesenes, disciples.

Conclusion: *JESUS* is the divine *SON* of *GOD*, sovereign over all physical ailments, over all circumstances, over the powers of nature, over the evil emissaries of satan and over sin (Matthew 9:5). Striking Facts: 29 While we may deny the deity and power of **CHRIST**, demons know the truth. **HIS** divine **SON**ship is proven mightly by the demonstration of **HIS** power in all places/times. **HE** was not only **SON** of **GOD**, but **SON** of Man (20, 24) and having been subjected to all human testings, **He** became a perfect sacrifice and substitute for all believers on the Cross.
